TALLER, SMALLER



There's nothing like pulling out your kid's clothes from last summer, to make you realize how much they've grown! This week we celebrate that size difference with the simple rhyme: "Taller, Smaller"

Body awareness and rhythmic movement are front and center for this rhyme/activity. Oftentimes it is the simplest of rhymes that engage the children the most. This little piece is proof of that pudding.

TALLER, SMALLER

When I stretch up, I feel so tall.
(stand up and reach hands up into the air)
 When I bend down, I feel so small.
(crouch down)
 Taller, taller, taller, taller
(slowly stand and raise arms)
 Smaller, smaller, smaller, smaller
(slowly crouch down)
 Into a tiny ball *(tuck in arms and head)*
